

**Central Flyway Retrievers (CFR)
Guarantee & Conditions Policy**

Overview - Hip Dysplasia

All puppies produced by CFR carry a 26-month (from date of birth) hip and elbow guarantee.

All puppies are sold in good faith. No dog is sold for a specific use or with a guarantee of performance, such as brood bitch, stud dog, show dog or field trial competitor.

You are the sole responsibility party for the care and maintenance of your puppy upon leaving our premises. Litter owners assume no financial responsibility for veterinary exams, vaccinations or treatments or diagnosis.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCE SHOULD YOU EUTHANIZE THIS DOG, except in the instance of traumatic accidental injury or other life-threatening situations where euthanization is the only humane alternative. Please read the remainder of the agreement regarding what to do if you choose not to keep this dog upon finding of a genetic hip defect.

YOUR PUP'S HEALTH AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE:

Your pup will have the following at the time of pickup or delivery:

1. Current worming and vaccinations Heath check-up at 8 weeks of age.
2. Health records, vet information and AKC registration papers provided for each puppy.
3. Removal of dewclaws.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO FOR THIS GUARANTEE TO REMAIN IN EFFECT:

4. Continue your pup's vaccination schedule in a timely manner and with all shots required by your veterinarian.
5. Maintain your pup on a monthly heartworm preventative beginning at the age indicated by your veterinarian.
6. Conduct CERF submission by 26 months of age.
7. Conduct OFA submission between 24 and 26 months of age.

Any items above not adhered to by the owner of said dog will void the guarantee.

In addition to the items above, we highly recommend a flea and tick prevention program as well as Lyme disease vaccination. Please consult your veterinarian regarding all healthcare issues for your dog.

Hips & Elbows:

To ensure the best possible environment for your dog's hips and elbow development, we request that your dog is not left for any period of time on slick surfaces, such as linoleum, hardware floors or tile. We also request that you do not let your dog jump off any high surfaces, including the back of pickup trucks. We encourage that your dog stays in areas that allow sure fogging and comfortable resting.

Your dog's hips and elbows must be x-rayed between 24 and 26 months of age and submitted to the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals. OFA is the final and ONLY authority on the state of your dog's joints. The refund process will begin ONLY after the dog is rated any level of dysplastic after OFA submissions.

If your dog has been rated any level of dysplastic, see below regarding the refund process.

REFUND PROCESS:

If your dog does not pass Elbow or Hip certification, please do the following:

1. Notify us immediately by telephone
2. Send notice in writing within 7 days via certified, overnight, or any other form of mail that can be tracked
3. Please submit within 30 days by any form of traceable mail a copy of the findings and appropriate material to be reviewed by our veterinarian. Our veterinarian will review the findings at our expense. If our veterinarian disagrees with the findings and upon resubmission of the OFA or CERF status changes to an acceptable rating, you may choose to keep the dog and end the refund/replacement request or submit the dog to an examination by a third party mutually agreed upon veterinarian to make an independent finding. This veterinarian's opinion and subsequent CERF or OFA rating will be final and binding upon the parties. Each party shall be responsible for one half of the costs incurred in submitting the dog for a third evaluation.

Claims are not considered valid until the owner has followed the processes outlined in the agreement and adhered to the terms stipulated stated herein.

REFUND:

We will refund 50% of the purchase price of the puppy under the following terms. You may keep your dog as he or she is part of your family and we would not expect you to return a family pet. We would just need to have you send us back the AKC registration papers and provide us with proof of spaying or neutering.

BUYER AGREES this puppy may only be bred after being fully tested for hips, elbows, EIC, CNM and may only be bred to AKC registered Labrador Retrievers that have been fully health tested for hips, elbows, EIC and CNM. **THIS DOG WILL NOT BE USED TO MAKE MIXED BREED PUPPIES.**

Puppy is being sold with AKC registration papers and may be registered by the new owner as his or her cost. All puppies have received a first distemper vaccine and have been dewormed on dates specified and dew claws have been removed.
